22q11.2 Deletion Syndrome is a genetic disorder caused by a small missing piece of the 22nd chromosome. It is believed to be the second most common genetic disorder behind Down Syndrome, yet most people have never heard of it or they know it by another name, such as VCFS or DiGeorge Syndrome.

Because each person diagnosed with 22q presents a unique set of the possible 180+ symptoms, ranging from mild to serious health and developmental issues that can affect every system in the body, it is difficult for even the best doctors to diagnose.

In the 22q community, one out of every 68 children are born with a heart defect, and many of those will need open heart surgery.
